

The Dunwoody Springs HOA asked HighGrove Partners to examine the existing development entry and make suggestions regarding the improvement of the landscape and hardscape. The \$100,000.00 budget covered the design and installation of new irrigation, lighting, planting, and a new hardscape/signage at the entry to Dunwoody Springs. One of the hardscape improvements involved reconfiguring the existing curb layout to make the planting space larger and improve the drainage. The scope of work including permitting the proposed improvements. In order to give the client an idea of what the proposed sign would look like, HG used Photoshop to add a rendering of the sign, and improvements images of trees and shrubs to a photograph of the existing conditions (please see right image below).
